TYPE BUSINESS DEFINITIONS

1. **Small Business Concern**

Small business concern” means a business, including its affiliates that is independently owned and operated, not dominant in the field of operation in which it is bidding and meets the size standards as prescribed in Government regulations. Consult your Regional or District Small Business Administration office if further clarification is needed.

2. **Large Business Concern**

A business concern that exceeds the small business size code standards established by the Small Business Administration as set forth in the Code of Federal Regulation, Title 13, Part 121.

3. **Woman-owned Small Business Concern**

Women-owned small business concern” means a small business concern that is at least 51 percent owned by one or more women; or, in the case of any publicly owned business, at least 51 percent of the stock of which is owned by one or more women; and whose management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more women. “Control,” in this context, means exercising the power to make policy decisions. “Operate,” in this context means actively involved in the day to day management.

4. **Minority-owned Large Business Concern**

A concern which meets the criteria and definition in category No 5, but which is not a small business by the U.S. Small Business Administration’s standards.

5. **Small Disadvantaged Business Concern**

“Small disadvantaged business concern” means an offeror that represents, as part of its offer, that it is a small business under the size standard applicable to the acquisition; and it has received certification as a small disadvantaged business concern consistent with 13 CFR part 124, subpart B; and

(i) No material change in disadvantaged ownership and control has occurred since its certification;

(ii) Where the concern is owned by one or more disadvantaged individuals, the net worth of each individual upon whom the certification is based does not exceed \$750,000 after taking into account the applicable exclusions set forth at 13 CFR 124.104(c)(2); and

(iii) It is identified, on the date of its representation, as a certified small disadvantaged business concern in the data base maintained by the Small Business Administration (PRO-Net).

6. **HUBZone Small Business Concern** HUBZone small business concern” means a small business concern that appears on the List of Qualified HUBZone Small Business Concerns maintained by the Small Business Administration.

7. **Veteran-owned Small Business Concern**

“Veteran-owned small business concern” means a small business concern not less than 51 percent of which is owned by one or more veterans (as defined at 38 U.S.C. 101(2)) or, in the case of any publicly owned business, not less than 51 percent of the stock of which is owned by one or more veterans; and the management and daily business operations of which are controlled by one or more veterans.

8. **Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business Concern –**

Service-disabled veteran-owned small business is defined as a small business concern that is (1) Not less than 51 percent of which is owned by one or more service-disabled veterans or, in the case of any publicly owned business, not less than 51 percent of the stock of which is owned by one or more service-disabled veterans; and (2) The management and daily business operations of which are controlled by one or more service-disabled veterans or, in the case of a service-disabled veteran with permanent and severe disability, the spouse or permanent caregiver of such veteran. Service-disabled veteran means a veteran, as defined in 38 U.S.C. 101(2), with a disability that is service-connected, as defined in 38 U.S.C. 101(16).

9. **Labor Surplus Area Labor surplus area concern –**

“Labor Surplus Area Concern” means a concern that together with its first-tier subcontractors will perform substantially in labor surplus areas. Performance is substantially in labor surplus areas if the costs incurred under the contract on account of manufacturing, production, or performance of appropriate services in labor surplus areas exceed 50 percent of the contract price.
