SRS'S ENVIRONMENTAL RESTORATION PROGRAM PASSES FOUR-YEAR SAFETY MILESTONE

AIKEN, S.C. (Oct. 19)—SRS's Environmental Restoration program passed four years without a work-related lost time injury or illness on October 9.

The program encompasses all employees of the Environmental Restoration Division plus others who work on the program—construction workers, radiation control technicians, subcontractors, etc.—which altogether averages about 450 people.

The four-year milestone represents approximately 3,400,000 safe hours of work.

"This achievement shows a real commitment to safety as our top priority," said Mike Sabbe, vice president and general manager of environmental restoration for the Westinghouse Savannah River Company team. "Every time this record is extended it underscores an excellent record of teamwork, because this milestone covers an extremely diverse group of people. They all have my personal thanks and congratulations for a job well done."
