## **SRS Employee United Way Campaign Raises Highest Charitable Total in Plant's History**

AIKEN, S.C., (October 9, 2001) – SRS employees recently celebrated another site record – raising over \$2.2 million for area United Way agencies. This is the highest level of employee giving in the history of the site's annual campaign.

Westinghouse Savannah River Company, Bechtel Savannah River Inc., BNFL Savannah River Corporation and BWXT Savannah River Company employees donated a grand total of \$2,272,405 during their annual employee United Way campaign.
