WSRC Team Employees Achieve 10 Million Safe Hours

AIKEN, S.C., (March 29)- Earlier this week, Westinghouse Savannah River Company (WSRC) Operations employees at the Savannah River Site reached a significant safety milestone – 10 million hours without an injury resulting in time away from work.

This marks the fifth time WSRC Team employees have achieved this milestone since 1989.

Coupled with this achievement, Operations employees also worked over a million hours without an employee being placed on work restrictions as a result of an injury. The site's Construction Department employees have also completed 1,006 days of work and over 5.9 million hours without a lost-time injury.

“This outstanding safety performance isn't dependent on luck, it takes every employee working together to identify and eliminate unsafe conditions and at-risk behaviors. I commend our employees for making this success possible,” said WSRC President Joe Buggy.
