NOMINATIONS SOUGHT FOR SRS COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARDS

AIKEN, S.C., March 1, 2001 – Nominations are currently being sought for the 2001 Westinghouse Savannah River Company (WSRC) Team "Employee Community Service Awards."

This award is open to any full-time SRS worker employed by the WSRC-led contractor team. Each year, several WSRC Team employees are recognized in this way, and, since 1990, the program has honored many deserving individuals.

Nominations may be submitted either by SRS employees or by individuals in the community who do not work at SRS but who are familiar with the nominee's contributions. Nominations may recognize short- and long-term community service efforts. (Individuals directly involved with the Community Service Awards Program administration or selection processes are ineligible.)

Nominations are being accepted now, and will remain open through 5 p.m., April 12.

Nominees will be evaluated based on the worthwhile nature and community impact of the service, and the employee's influence, amount of time devoted and length of service. Winners are honored at a luncheon.
