ENVIRONMENTAL RESTORATION TECHNOLOGY CONFERENCE TO BE HELD JULY 17-19, 2001

AIKEN, S.C., January 22 – The Savannah River Operations office of the Department of Energy will host the Environmental Restoration Technology End User Conference on July 17-19 at the Westin Peachtree Hotel in Atlanta, Georgia.

The three principal purposes of the conference are (1) to share cleanup successes and technical innovations from DOE sites and from the two co-sponsoring federal agencies—the Department of Defense and the Environmental Protection Agency; (2) promote the field deployment of innovative technologies; and (3) improve teamwork in cleanup among the agencies and the state regulatory bodies.

Two days of meetings at the hotel will be followed by a tour of an Atlanta area Department of Defense cleanup site, for those interested, on July 19.

The conference will include panel sessions and presentations on various environmental technologies. Proposed topics are passive and natural remediation with monitored natural attenuation, cost effective process control and monitoring of remediation systems, electronic knowledge management techniques.

Conference organizers have called for interested authors to submit abstracts starting immediately.
