Aiken, S.C., February 1 -- In honor of National Engineers Week, the Savannah River Site is sponsoring Technology Day 2001, Wednesday, Feb. 7, at the Augusta-Richmond County Civic Center.

Over 95 SRS exhibits will feature SRS engineering and technology accomplishments. Thirteen hundred area middle and high school students visit the exhibits from 8:30 a.m. – 12 p.m.
