ANNUAL SRS SUMMER FOOD DRIVE RAISES OVER \$10,000 FOR THE CSRA

AIKEN, S.C. (June 9)--The Projects, Design, and Construction Services (PD&CS) and Soil and Groundwater Closure Projects (SGCP) organizations at the Savannah River Site jointly raised \$10,129 in the last four weeks in their annual summer food drive, in addition to food items, for the Golden Harvest Food Bank.

The SRS summer food drive is one of Golden Harvest Food Bank's largest fund-raisers in the local community. The annual summer drive originally began in 1991 in the construction department. In 1997 organizers extended the food drive to the division level. Later, a second division became a joint sponsor.

According to long-time PD&CS food drive chair Sheri Still, the food drive has yielded more than \$177,000 to Golden Harvest. "We're proud to be able to continue our effort to fight hunger in the Central Savannah River Area. Unfortunately, hunger is far more widespread in the area than most people realize. As employees at SRS we want to do our part to face and solve these problems," Still said.

SRS is host annually to two food drives. The winter holiday food drive is scheduled for the end of this year.
