## Over 6,000 Area Students Attend College Night 2012

### *\$14,000 in Scholarships Awarded to Area Students*

Aiken, S.C., (Sept. 19, 2012) — Over 6,000 high school students from the greater Aiken-Augusta area recently met with recruiters from more than 150 colleges and universities during this year's CSRA College Night.

Scholarships, each worth \$1,000, were awarded to 14 students attending the event recently held at Augusta's James Brown Arena.

"We were thrilled with this year's attendance," said Gladys Moore, Program Coordinator, Savannah River Nuclear Solutions, LLC. "At times, the arena was packed, wall to wall, with enthusiastic students eager to obtain much needed information from numerous colleges."

To qualify for a College Night scholarship, students must be high school juniors or seniors and graduate with a GPA equal or above 2.5 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent). Students must also attend and register in person at CSRA College Night to be eligible.
