## Savannah River Site Citizens Advisory Board Seeking New Members

Aiken, S.C.—The Department of Energy (DOE) is seeking new members interested in volunteering for a two-year term on the Savannah River Site (SRS) Citizens Advisory Board (CAB). The SRS CAB is a community board that provides advice and recommendations, from a community perspective, to DOE regarding environmental cleanup activities taking place at SRS.

The SRS CAB is a part of the DOE Environmental Management Site-Specific Advisory Board, a stakeholder board that provides the Assistant Secretary for Environmental Management and designees with advice, information, and recommendations on issues affecting the EM program at various sites. Among those issues are cleanup standards and environmental restoration; waste management and disposition; stabilization and disposition of non-stockpile nuclear materials; excess facilities; future land use and long-term stewardship; risk assessment and management; and clean-up science and technology activities.

The board's membership is carefully considered to reflect a full diversity of viewpoints in the affected community and region. Board members are composed of people who are directly affected by DOE site cleanup activities.

No special training or knowledge of SRS is required to serve on the Board. Applicants with an interest in their community and who can commit up to 20 hours per month attending meetings and studying issues and are willing to work to develop a group consensus of ideas are encouraged to apply. Several CAB vacancies exist for the upcoming 2016 year.

The CAB is made up of citizens from Georgia and South Carolina. Those living outside of the SRS area are reimbursed at the Government rate for travel and lodging when required.
