SRS TO SHARE SAFETY INFORMATION AT JUNE 15 OPEN HOUSE

Aiken, S.C., June 11 – The Savannah River Site is holding its ninth safety open house for the community. Admission for the open house is free, and is scheduled for 6-8 p.m. on Tuesday, June 15, at the University of South Carolina Aiken. Exhibits will be located in the Business & Education Building (Conference Center) gymnasium and Parking Lot C. The exhibits will be open to SRS employees and the general public.

Since 1996, SRS has invited the public to learn more about the safety culture on site and browse exhibits featuring some of the latest technology used in the world of safety. This community event is in conjunction with the SRS annual Safety Conference for site employees, a two-day event designed to reinforce good safety habits on and off the job.

The open house will feature over 70 informational and interactive exhibits. Some exhibits of particular interest to families include Fire safety – the Martinez Smoke House will teach children what to do in case of a fire; SRS’s safety mascot, Top Dog, will be there to interact with children; SRS Emergency vehicles will be displayed and much more.
