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This committee reviews the management, treatment, storage and disposition of radioactive wastes, including transuranic waste (TRU), low-level waste (LLW), mixed low-level waste (MLLW) and radioactive liquid waste (LW) and provides advice and recommendations to DOE on these activities. Principal goals of the committee are: to see (1) a trend of reduction in risk to the public, workers, and the environment posed by these wastes, and (2) integrated and comprehensive systems approaches used in weighing SRS waste management and disposition options. Topics under consideration for the Waste Management Committee in 2014 include:

- Salt Waste Processing Facility (SWPF) Project Baseline
- New Generation Solvent Operation Performance
- TRU Waste Program (including Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP) status continuously newly generated waste)
- Glass Waste Storage Building (GWSB) Program Update (including funding restraints/ impacts and comparison between drivers)
- Update on Saltstone Disposal Units (SDU) Vault #4
- Tank Closure Status
