FONSI for Biomass Cogeneration and Heating Facilities at SRS Available for Review

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has issued a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for the final environmental assessment (EA) entitled Biomass Cogeneration and Heating Facilities at the Savannah River Site (SRS) (DOE/EA-1605). The facilities will consist of two energy conservation measures: a new biomass cogeneration facility to replace the existing coal-fired D Area powerhouse; and two new biomass heating plants, one in K Area and one in L Area to replace the existing oil-fired steam plant in K Area.
