DOE Complex Transformation SPEIS Public Hearing

The Department of Energy's National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) is inviting comments related to the Draft Complex Transformation Supplemental Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement (SPEIS). Comments will assist NNSA in finalizing the SPEIS. The SPEIS analyzes the potential environmental impacts of alternatives for continuing the transformation of the nation's nuclear weapons complex to one that is smaller, more efficient, more secure and less expensive that leverages the scientific and technical capabilities of the workforce, and meets national security requirements. NNSA will conduct public hearings to discuss issues and receive comments as follows:

DOE Holds Public Information Workshop

The Department of Energy's Savannah River Operations Office will hold a public information workshop to discuss P-Reactor End State on February 28, 2008 at Aiken Technical College Amphitheater. This workshop will provide public information and solicit stakeholder input on the Department's end state decision.

DOE is currently deactivating the P-Reactor at the Savannah River Site. Upon completion of deactivation the reactor will undergo decommissioning. This workshop will be the second to provide local residents with information about the Department's reactor end-state options, reactor fundamentals, assessment modeling approach and a regulatory perspective.
