Public Invited to Comment

Hazardous Waste Permit Modification Requested

The United States Department of Energy (DOE) Savannah River Operations Office has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) modifications to Volume II of the 2000 Savannah River Site (SRS) Hazardous Waste Permit Application for the Hazardous Waste Storage Facility (HWSF). This revision (Revision 3 of Volume II) transfers waste treatment capacity from the HWSF to the Transuranic (TRU) Waste Storage Facility to facilitate TRU waste processing.

This notice begins a 60-day public comment period. More information, including the actual permit application, is available for review and copying at the DOE Public Reading Room located in the University of South Carolina (USC)-Aiken campus in Aiken, SC or by contacting personnel identified in this notice. SRS's compliance history during the life of the permit being modified is available from SCDHEC. Written comments may be sent to SCDHEC. All comments will be considered in the final decision.
