DOE Makes Request to Modify Corrective Action Groundwater Monitoring Programs

On March 31, 2003, the Department of Energy (DOE) at the Savannah River Site requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) Class 2 permit modifications that included changes to the F- and H-Area Hazardous Waste Management Facilities corrective action groundwater monitoring programs. At that time, we sent out a public notice of our request.

As of this date, SCDHEC has not made a decision on this request. The purpose of this second notice is to inform you that if SCDHEC does not approve or deny this request by January 22, 2007, then SRS will be authorized to implement the monitoring programs as described in the permit modification for the life of the permit [reference South Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Regulations R.61-79.270.42(b)(6)].

Hazardous Waste Permit Modification Requested

The Department of Energy (DOE)-Savannah River Operations Office has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) modifications to Savannah River Site's (SRS) 2000 Resource Conservation and Recover Act (RCRA) Part B Permit Renewal Application for Volume I. This volume of the application contains general information about each of the permitted facilities at SRS and information that is common to many of the facilities.

The revision (rev 8 of Volume I) proposes alternate methods for the analysis of many radionuclides and deletes the RCRA Training Plan for the six SRS RCRA Post-Closure Care facilities.

This notice begins a 60 day comment period. More information, including the actual permit applications, is available for review and copying at the DOE Public Reading Room located in the University of South Carolina-Aiken Library, or by contacting personnel identified in this notice. The Permittee's compliance history during the life of the permit being modified is available from SCDHEC.

A public meeting will be held on Monday, December 18, 2:00 p.m. at the Aiken County Public Library. Representatives from SRS will be available to answer questions on the modifications. Written Comments may be sent to SCDHEC. All comments will be considered in the final decision.
