DOE Makes Request to Modify the RCRA Permit

On December 1, 2006, the Department of Energy (DOE) at the Savannah River Site requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) a Class 2 permit modification proposing alternate methods for the analysis of many radionuclides and deletes the Resource Conservation Recovery Act (RCRA) Training Plan for the six SRS RCRA Post-Closure Care facilities. At that time, we sent out a public notice informing you of our request. In addition, a public meeting was held on December 18, 2006.

As of this date, SCDHEC has not made a decision on this request. The purpose of this second notice is to inform you that if SCDHEC does not approve or deny this request by October 4, 2007, then SRS will be authorized to implement these proposed changes as described in the permit modification for the life of the permit [reference South Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Regulations R.61-79.270.42(b)(6)].
