DOE Makes Temporary Request to Stabilize Chemicals at the Hydrogen Technology Research Laboratory

The Department of Energy (DOE) at the Savannah River Site has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) a temporary authorization request to stabilize chemicals at the Hydrogen Technology Research Laboratory.

The request is to deactivate four bottles of chemicals so they can be safely shipped to an off-site vendor for further treatment and disposal.
