## **DOE Makes Temporary Request to Store Tanker of Sump Water in the F Area**

The Department of Energy (DOE) at the Savannah River Site has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) a temporary authorization request to store 3500 gallons of F Area Canyon sump water in a tanker in the F Area.

The request is to temporarily store the sump water until it can be repackaged into smaller containers and move to one of the SRS RCRA permitted facilities for storage until it can be shipped to an off-site vendor for treatment and disposal.
