Draft Surplus Plutonium Disposition Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement Available to Public

DOE is planning to publish the Draft Surplus Plutonium Disposition Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (Draft SPD SEIS) in the fall of 2008. Standard distribution for this Draft SEIS will be a hard copy of the Summary and a CD of the complete Draft SPD SEIS. In addition, the Draft SPD SEIS will also be available on the Internet, and at the University of South Carolina-Aiken Gregg-Graniteville Library and the South Carolina State Library, 1500 Senate Street, Columbia.
