DOE Issues Draft Workforce Restructuring Plan for Public Comment

The U.S. Department of Energy's Savannah River Operations Office (DOE-SR) issued for public comment a draft *Workforce Restructuring Plan, Fiscal Year 2009* that covers the contractor workforces at the Savannah River Site for public comments.

A 10 business-day public comment period begins July 6, 2009, and ends on July 17, 2009.

Section 3161 of the Defense Authorization Act of 1993 and DOE order 350.1 requires that sites periodically revise their workforce restructuring plans to reflect current conditions. There are no current plans for any workforce reductions at SRS. The draft plan covers the major prime contractors reporting to DOE-SR and performing work at SRS. It establishes the general framework within which any restructuring of the workforce at SRS would be implemented and the benefits that would be offered.
