Class 2 Notice has been Requested for a Savannah River Site Hazardous Waste Permit Modification

The United States Department of Energy (DOE)-Savannah River Operations Office has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) modifications to Savannah River Site's (SRS) 2000 Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit Renewal Application for Volumes IV and V. These modifications propose changes to the groundwater corrective action goals for the F and H Area Hazardous Waste Management Facilities.

These revisions (Revision 1 to Volumes IV and V) propose to change the Phase 2b goals for the groundwater corrective action plans to exclude meeting the groundwater protection standards for tritium in the seeplines.

This notice begins a 60 day comment period. More information, including the actual permit applications, is available for review and copying at the DOE Public Reading Room located in the University of South Carolina-Aiken Library, or by contacting personnel identified in this notice. The Permittee's compliance history during the life of the permit being modified is available from SCDHEC.

A public meeting will be held on Tuesday, November 24, 2009, 3:00 p.m. at the Aiken County Public Library. Representatives from SRS will be available to answer questions on the modifications. Written Comments may be sent to SCDHEC. All comments will be considered in the final decision.
