Department of Energy's Savannah River Operations Office will host Public Meeting to Continue Community Discussion on Energy Park Concept at the Savannah River Site

The Department of Energy's (DOE) Savannah River Operations Office (SR) will host a three-hour public meeting to continue community discussion on the concept of an energy park at the Savannah River Site, which was addressed at a previous public workshop held in August of 2009.

The follow up meeting will be held 1:00 p.m.- 4:00 p.m., April 15, 2010 at the Savannah Rapids Pavilion, 3300 Evans to Lock Road, Martinez, Georgia, 30907.

At this meeting DOE will discuss the status of the development of the energy park concept at SRS, including updates on energy park activities at DOE Headquarters, actions at other sites, and the development of energy park concepts at SRS.

DOE wants to foster open discussion of the role that SRS and the Central Savannah River Area (CSRA) can play in the future energy economy. Presentations will be followed by ample time for questions and discussion.
