Hazardous Waste Permit Modification Requested for the Savannah River Site

The United States Department of Energy (DOE)-Savannah River Operations Office has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC), a modification to Savannah River Site's (SRS) 1992 Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit Renewal Application for Volume IV.

This revision (Revision 26 of Volume IV) proposes to add silver chloride injection to the Corrective Action Plan of the F-Area Hazardous Waste Management Facility (HWMF) for the treatment of iodine-129 in the groundwater.

This notice begins a 60 day comment period. More information, including the actual permit applications, is available for review and copying at the DOE Public Reading Room located in the University of South Carolina-Aiken Library, or by contacting personnel identified in this notice. The Permittee's compliance history during the life of the permit being modified is available from SCDHEC.

A public meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 4, 2011, 3:30 p.m. at the Aiken County Public Library. Representatives from SRS will be available to answer questions on the modifications. Written Comments may be sent to SCDHEC. All comments will be considered in the final decision.
