*The U.S. Department of Energy announces the Public Meeting for the Draft Environmental Assessment for the Acceptance and Disposition of Spent Nuclear Fuel Containing U.S.-Origin Highly Enriched Uranium from the Federal Republic of Germany*

Public meeting will begin at **6:30 p.m.** with a half-hour **Open House** during which the public may sign-up to give oral comments, obtain information materials, and speak informally with technical staff and Department of Energy (DOE) officials.

**At 7:00 p.m.**, DOE will give a brief presentation on the Draft Environmental Assessment for the Acceptance and Disposition of Spent Nuclear Fuel Containing U.S.-Origin Highly Enriched Uranium from the Federal Republic of Germany (Draft Spent Nuclear Fuel from Germany EA). After the presentation, members of the public will be invited to provide comments on the Draft Spent Nuclear Fuel from Germany EA. The comments will be recorded by a court reporter. The meeting is scheduled to end at **9:00 p.m.**
