- Don't let your family become a statistic...Be prepared to have a **SAFE SUMMER ON THE ROAD.**




Prepare for Fun and Safe Travel

- Take the following with you ...


- | a first aid kit

Avoid Dangerous Mistakes on the Road

- Pull off to make your cell phone calls
- Yellow lights mean "SLOW DOWN"
- Remember the 2-second rule when behind another vehicle



10 Ways To Avoid Road Rage

- Be courteous behind the wheel.
