

## **SAVANNAH RIVER SITE PUBLIC TOUR ACCEPTABLE ID LIST**

All visitors to the Savannah River Site must provide **two forms** of identity source documents in original forms. The identifications should be bound to the person presenting the document and must be neither expired nor cancelled. If two source documents bear different names, evidence of a formal name change shall be provided. To receive a Visitor's Badge granting access to the site.

- One must be a valid photo identification document from **List A** below.
- The second ID should be from **List A or B**

**All visitors will also be required to provide their Social Security Number  
on the day of the tour.**

1. U.S. Passport (unexpired)	1. <i>U.S. Social Security card, issued by the Social Security Administration</i>

Driver's license or ID card issued by a state or outlying possession of the United States provided it contains a photograph	2. <i>Original or certified copy of a birth certificate issued by a state, county, municipal authority, possession or outlying possession of the United States bearing an official seal</i>
3. U.S. Military ID Card	3. <i>ID card issued by a federal, state, or local government agency or entity, provided it contains a photograph (Medicare/VA/ Insurance Card is not a valid form of identification.)</i>
4. U.S. Military Dependent's ID Card	4. <i>Voter's registration card</i>
5. Personal Identity Verification (PIV) Card	5. <i>U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card</i>
6. DOE issued Savannah River Site Badge. <b>(Note all SRS employees are REQUIRED to bring their badge the day of their scheduled tour.)</b>	6. <i>Native American tribal document</i>
