### EXPERIENCE

Alice Doswell serves as Senior Vice President of Environmental Stewardship, Safety and Health (ES&SH) for Savannah River Nuclear Solutions (SRNS), the management and operations contractor for the Department of Energy's (DOE) Savannah River Site (SRS). In this role, she has Site-wide responsibility for occupational safety and health, industrial hygiene, worker safety and health, medical services, environmental compliance, environmental remediation projects, environmental sampling and analysis, and radiological protection. She also ensures ES&SH programs are compliant with DOE contract requirements.

Doswell previously led the ESSH organization where she had Site-wide responsibility for safeguards, security and emergency services in addition to her current assignment.

Prior to joining SRNS in 2011, Doswell served as the Environment, Safety, Health and Quality (ESH&Q) manager for Parsons at the Salt Waste Processing Facility Project at SRS. Her responsibilities included planning and executing the ESH&Q program including quality assurance, quality control, industrial hygiene, worker safety and health, occupational medicine, industrial and construction safety and radiation protection. Doswell previously worked at BWXT Services as a senior program manager providing executive insights and technical solutions for a broad range of facilities, programs, and projects, including contract management performance and compliance issues at three DOE sites. Doswell also served for 13 years as a DOE employee in positions of increasing management responsibility including Site level responsibility for ESH&Q including contractor assurance and emergency management, Area Closure Projects, Solid and Transuranic Waste Management and Nuclear Laboratory Operations.

Doswell brings over 35 years of experience and additional professional certifications to her position. She serves on the Board of Directors for the Aiken Chapter of the American Red Cross.
