Through partnerships with government agencies, educational institutions, and local communities, the program provides hands-on training, job-specific education, and professional development for apprentices across three key models.

Gain professional experience with paid, hands-on training through our Professional/Degree Based Apprenticeship Program. Designed for careers in Engineering, IT, and Business Management, this program offers:

- Paid on-the-job training (1,000 hours/year for up to 4 years for some programs)
- Job-related competency development
- A nationally recognized U.S. Department of Labor credential
- Potential full-time employment opportunities at SRNS

Entry Requirements

- Must be 18 years or older
- High school diploma or GED
- U.S. citizenship required for security-cleared positions (See DOE Order 472.2)
- Successful completion of SRS General Employee Training and substance abuse screening
- Enrollment in a 2-year or 4-year college or university pursuing a related degree (for select apprenticeships)
