The Savannah River Site (SRS) Apprenticeship School is a structured workforce development initiative aimed at building a highly skilled, diverse workforce. Through partnerships with government agencies, educational institutions, and local communities, the program provides hands-on training, job-specific education, and professional development for apprentices across three key models.

Join our 24-month program designed for high school juniors and seniors. Earn your diploma while gaining hands-on experience at SRS. On completion, receive a certificate as a Youth Apprentice from the Department of Labor.

Entry Requirements

- Age 16 or older
- High school junior or senior
- U.S. citizen and valid driver's license
- Reliable personal transportation
- Ability to work part-time Monday-Thursday

Available Positions

Junior Records Management Clerk

- **Role/Duties:** Perform office tasks, customer interaction, filing, data entry, using office equipment, and distribute reports.
- **Is this role for me?** Yes, if you are organized, proficient in Microsoft Office, communicate well, and follow procedures.

Junior Informational Technology Technician

- **Role/Duties:** Gain hands-on IT experience, support, PC administration, customer service, and perform supervised tasks.
- **Is this role for me?** Yes, if you are an IT CTAE pathway student, work independently, and follow procedures.

Junior Emergency Medical Service Technician

- **Role/Duties:** Observe SRS Fire Department in emergency services, training, drills, participate in ride-alongs, and take vitals under supervision.
- **Is this role for me?** Yes, if you're in the EMS CTAE pathway, are interested in emergency services, have relevant training, and follow safety protocols.

Junior Project Controls Engineer

- **Role/Duties:** Manage capital project lifecycles, planning, monitoring, cost and schedule management, risk and change management.
- **Is this role for me?** Yes, if you have a strong work ethic and are interested in project management.

Junior Business Analyst

- **Role/Duties:** Manage cost and accounting operations, payroll services, cost control, and financial planning and analysis.
- **Is this role for me?** Yes, if you have a strong work ethic, excel in math, and are interested in finance operations.
