### Categories

#### A

#### Category A (\$500)

Classroom Teachers Only: Grant proposals for the purchase of basic supplies and materials for use in a single classroom in conjunction with student centered activities.

#### B

#### Category B\* (\$750)

Grant proposal for equipment to enhance hands-on science, mathematics or technology programs, which will be used in a single classroom or grade level.

#### C

#### Category C\* (\$1,000)

Grant proposal for equipment to implement a science, mathematics, or technology project, which will be used by more than one grade or the entire school.

\* Applications for Category B and C require a project plan and implementation schedule.

Mini Grants recipients may be photographed, filmed, videotaped, or otherwise recorded during the awards reception.
