Environmental Remediation and Waste Management Subcommittee

**Meeting Record
September 22, 1997**

The CAB ER&WM subcommittee met on September 22, 1997 at the Marine Corps Air Station in Beaufort, SC. CAB members present included, CAB ER&WM subcommittee Co-chairs, Bill Lawless and Kathryn May and Karen Patterson. Todd Crawford, technical consultant to the CAB and Walt Joseph, CAB facilitator, also attended. Attending from DOE-SR were Phil Prater, Thomas Johnson, Dale Ormond and Gary Little. Attending from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) were Ann Ragan, Jim Brownlow, and Cecilia De'Prete. Attending from WSRC/BSRI/BNFL were Sonny Goldston, Mary Flora, Brent Daugherty, and Anne Roe. Gary Little attended as the Associate Designated Deputy Federal Official, ADDFO.

Bill Lawless opened the meeting and asked everyone to introduce themselves.

Phil Prater discussed the Plug-In Record of Decision approach, which was developed to streamline the evaluation of similar sites for remediation. Mr. Prater reviewed the presentation he would give to the full CAB meeting the next day. A draft motion on the Plug-In ROD Approach was reviewed and discussed.

Brent Daugherty reviewed his presentation for the full CAB on the Complex-Wide Environmental Management Integration (EMI) plan and its SRS specific issues dealing with low-level waste, the utilization of the Consolidated Incineration Facility, (CIF), mixed low-level waste, and the transuranic (TRU) waste. Karen Patterson reviewed the two draft EMI motions.

Thomas Johnson gave a brief update on the decommissioning of excess facilities at SRS. A draft motion on Decommissioning of Nuclear Facilities at SRS and Decommissioning of Three Small Reactors was reviewed and discussed.
