The Subcommittee was still of the opinion that an EIS was not needed in this case and that it was there understanding there were other avenues to achieve the same end result, such as the CERCLA documentation recommended by the regulators which had to be done anyway, and that in general an EIS shouldn't be done unless there was the potential for or the question of a significant environmental impact.

<u>MWMF Southwest Plume:</u> Karen Patterson read the draft motion to the meeting attendees. There was significant discussion on the motion by the attendees. However, there were those that believed that something should be done, and that the scientific evaluations supporting the action should be produced first before the action should take place. After some debate the subcommittee decided to proceed with the latter recommendation.
