

Summary Notes – June 12th, 2018
 Savannah River Site (SRS) Citizens Advisory Board (CAB)
 Facilities Disposition & Site Remediation (FDSR) Committee Meeting

The SLM Committee held a meeting on Tuesday, June 12th, 2018, from 4:30 – 6:20 pm, at the Department of Energy Meeting Center in Aiken, SC. It was also streamed online via YouTube and posted to the CAB website and YouTube channel. The purpose of this meeting was to receive updates on the Point of Contact status. Ms. Underwood welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Point of Contact Status Update: Avery Hammett, DOE-SR

Ms. Hammett reviewed the current projects related to the committee prevue.

Q&A Session

Mr. Malik asked if a closure plan was done. Ms. Hammett answered yes, it was and it was submitted to DHEC in 2017. She further noted the changes are to bring it to align with the contents of the closure plan, which include contact information, contingency, and closure plans. Mr. Malik then asked if this is under RCRA or CRCLA. Ms. Hammett replied RCRA.

Committee Discussion: Final Appendix E

Mr. Malik asked what part of the FFA covers the closure plan. Ms. Hammett responded Appedix H. Mr. Malik asked what Appendix C covers. Ms. Hammett answered that it is a list of all waste units on site which is about 515. Ms. McFalls added that tank farms C, E, K & multiple others are covered, and closures are under IWT with the FFA.

Mr. Kaminski noted the dates have shifted significantly, and asked if that was discussed at the May full board meeting. Mr. Smith replied yes. Mr. Malik added that it was based on the budget. Ms. Hammett answered the discussions were mostly based on the work in D Area which caused the dates to shift to a sooner start date for projects. She further noted that DOE was able to move up Dunbarton Bay and groundwater remediation. The committee members then discussed possible new topics for recommendations with no clear definitive direction being decided upon.
