Committee Welcome: Tom French, Committee Chair

Mr. French welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Committee Discussion

Mr. French wanted to discuss the Integrated Priority Letter (IPL) which discusses budget. Mr. French edited the letter which was given to the CAB at the March Full Board. He took out the Program Baseline Summary numbers. He thought Cyber Security should be moved up in the priority list.

Mr. French wanted the group to look at the Payment in Lieu of Taxes (PILT). Mr. Vovakes said he thought PILT hadn’t been funded in years. Mr. Todd said PILT had been funded in the President’s budget in previous years but was eliminated in two years ago. Mr. French said PILT was very important from a community standpoint. Mr. Todd agreed because some towns depend on receiving the tax money.

Mr. Malik asked if Hazardous Waste was included under the Liquid Waste line item. Mr. Todd was not sure it would be. Mr. French said the CAB should list the top necessary items and wasn’t sure listing all the different of wastes should be included.

Mr. Todd reviewed all the line items listed on the previous IPL. He mentioned which ones needed the most assistance.

Mr. French suggested breaking Cyber Security into its own category and it should be listed. Mr. Vovakes wanted to know if Savannah River Nuclear Solutions covered most of Cyber Security, if

so then it shouldn't move in the IPL. Mr. Mikolanis (DOE-SR) said security is considered Min-Safe so it will always be in the budget.

Mr. Kaminski said he thought SWPF and infrastructure should be the top two items. SWPF needs to start on time and infrastructure is needed to order keep missions on site going.

Mr. French said he would review all the comments and make notes. All the information will be passed on to Mr. Vovakes since Mr. French will not be able to attend the May Full Board.
