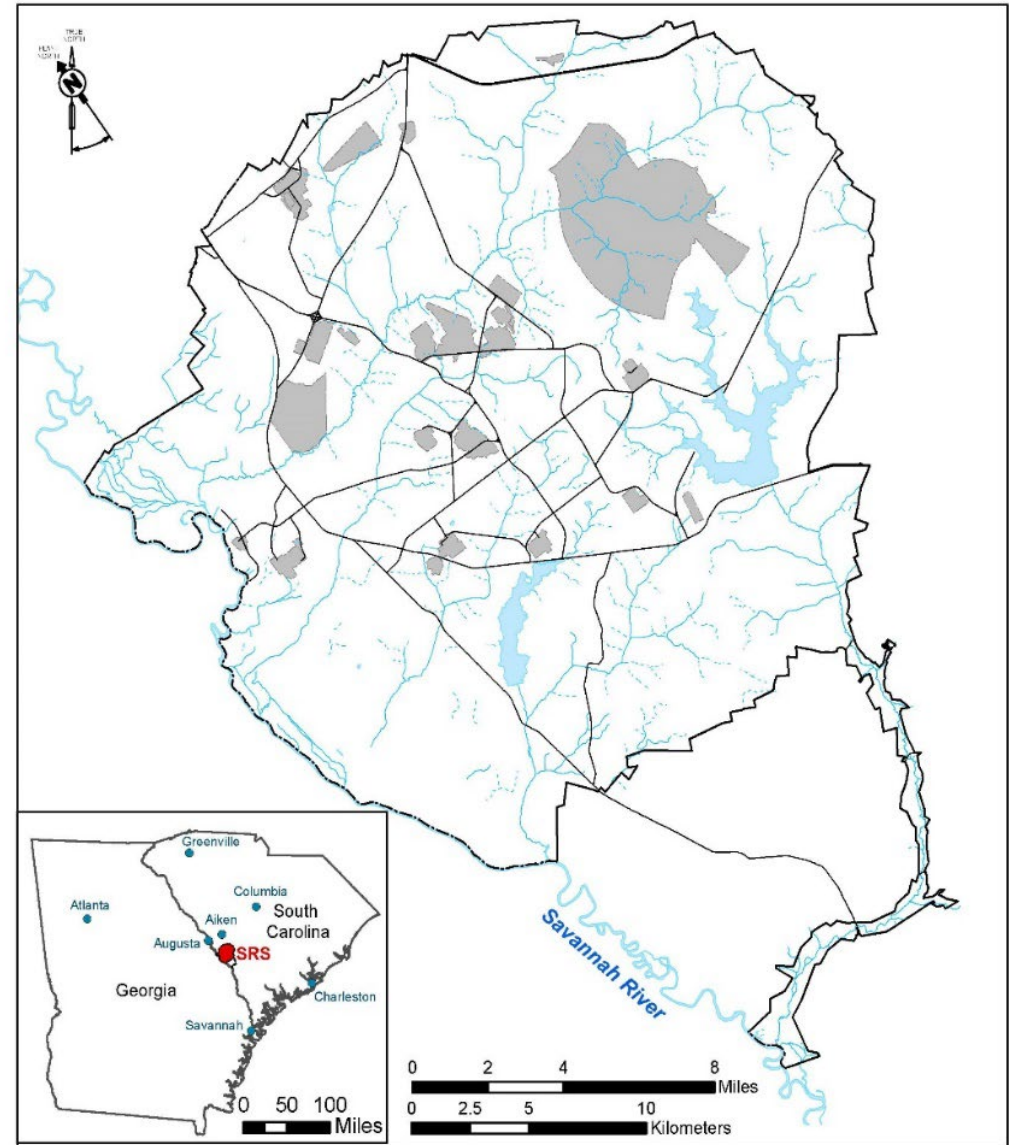

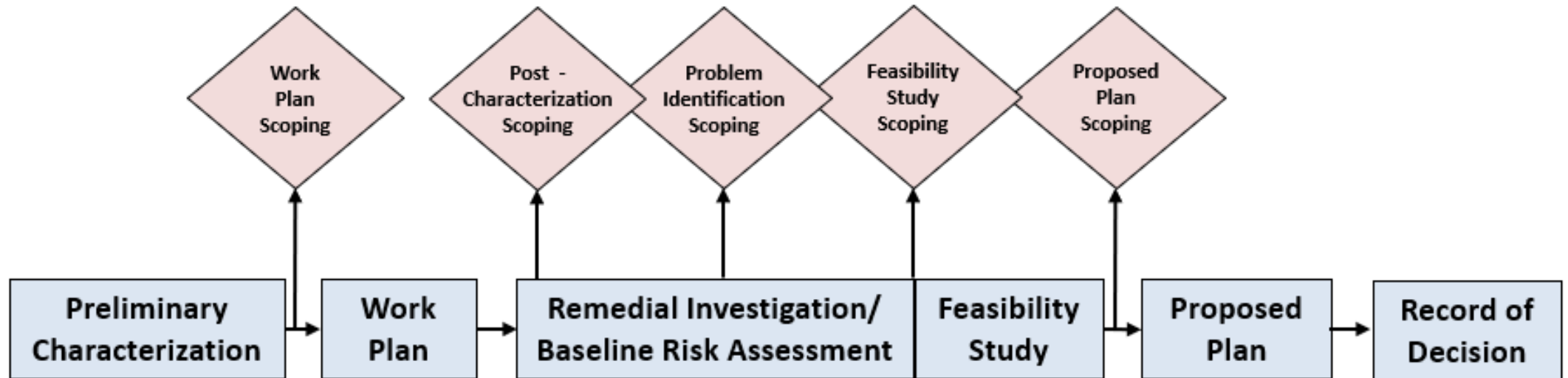

How do we reach a remedy?

- Multiple scoping meetings over multiple years
- Multiple CERCLA/RCRA documents over multiple years
- A remedy is selected
 - Excavation and Disposal and Land Use Controls

How can you participate?

- Once the Statement of Basis/Proposed Plan is finalized,
 - A 45-day public comment period begins
 - Environmental Bulletins are distributed as well as radio and newspaper announcements are made
- Public comments are addressed in the Responsiveness Summary within the Record of Decision
- Once the ROD has been signed by the DOE, EPA, and SCDES,
 - A public notice is made announcing that the ROD is now in the library reading rooms; and
 - The SRS RCRA permit will then be modified.

What happens after the ROD is signed?

- A regulatory walkdown occurs
 - Verify that the selected remedy has begun
- As per CERCLA, a five-year remedy review is conducted
 - Again, verifying that the selected remedy is still protective of human health and the environment
- In the meantime, SCDES strives to have a visible presence at the site through oversight of all environmental activities.
