Notification of Use of Remnant of Decommissioned 247-F Facility

DOE-Savannah River has transferred the fenced area, which includes the remnant of the decommissioned 247-F Facility, to the MOX Fuel Fabrication Facility Project for conversion to a parking site. The designated fixed contamination area, where activity levels were found to be acceptably low, was covered with an initial inch of concrete and subsequently, the entire area was covered with crushed stone and a top covering of asphalt. Concrete was placed over the fixed contamination area to preclude potential disturbance of the area by heavy equipment.

Use of the area for parking is consistent with the Industrial Worker scenario evaluated in both the Decommissioning Project Final Report for the facility and subsequent risk evaluation, and is protective of human health. Conclusions derived from risk assessments of residual contaminants across the remnant of the decommissioned facility reflect that there are no noncarcinogenic hazards nor any constituents of concern identified.

Materials being used to construct the parking area can be removed to address any future Federal Facility Agreement (FFA) requirements for evaluation and remediation activities that may be necessary during the Area Completion of the F-Area. Consistent with its listing on Appendix C.4, Deactivation & Decommissioning Facilities or Remnants that May Warrant Response Actions, of the FFA, this remnant will be evaluated as part of the Area Completion for F-Area.
