Hazardous Waste Permit Modification Requested

The United States Department of Energy (DOE)-Savannah River Operations Office has requested from the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) modifications to Savannah River Site's (SRS) 1992 Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B Permit Renewal Application for Volume IV. This modification adds components to the F-Area Hazardous Waste Management Facilities (HWMF) base injection system.

This revision (Revision 23 of Volume IV) proposes to permanently add base injection wells, that were installed under a temporary authorization, to the corrective action system. These base injection wells are located at the eastern most edge of the F Area HWMF underground barrier wall system and in the seep lines.

This notice begins a 60 day comment period. More information, including the actual permit applications, is available for review and copying at the DOE Public Reading Room located in the University of South Carolina-Aiken Library, or by contacting personnel identified in this notice. The Permittee's compliance history during the life of the permit being modified is available from SCDHEC.

A public meeting will be held on Wednesday, December 23rd, 3:00 p.m. at the Aiken County Public Library. Representatives from SRS will be available to answer questions on the modifications. Written Comments may be sent to SCDHEC. All comments will be considered in the final decision.
