## SRS SRPPF RCRA Pre-application Public Availability Session

The Public Availability Session is an opportunity to engage with SRS before its submittal of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part B permit application for the storage of hazardous waste associated with Savannah River Plutonium Processing Facility (SRPPF) operations. This meeting allows the community to receive information about waste management activities, ask questions, and provide input on issues and concerns.

SRPPF is located in F Area at SRS and establishes a capability at SRS for producing war reserve certified pits for the U.S. nuclear weapons stockpile. SRPPF operations will generate waste materials that will be regulated under RCRA as hazardous or mixed waste. The SRPPF hazardous waste treatment, storage, and disposal buildings will require a RCRA hazardous waste permit under the South Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Regulations.
