### POSITION

As the Director of Mission Assurance at the Savannah River National Laboratory, Campbell oversees quality assurance assessments, develops and tracks performance metrics, identifies deficiencies and risks, executes corrective actions, and supports procedural and contractual compliance for lab operations – all of which, cross multiple lab components, requiring in depth coordination of systems, resources, and information.

### EXPERIENCE

Campbell possesses more than twenty-nine years of combined executive experience in the federal government and private sector. As the Assistant Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Criminal Investigative Division, he directed all FBI national and international criminal strategies and investigations, and as a Special Agent Inspector, he conducted audits and reviews of all FBI investigative programs, shooting incidents, and financial and administrative functions in domestic FBI Field Offices and foreign Legal Attachés. His FBI responsibilities also included directing counterterrorism, counterintelligence, and law enforcement intelligence gathering and investigations related to the safety and security of the nation's nuclear defense capabilities and nuclear power facilities. Campbell previously worked as a Director with Navigant Consulting, Inc., conducting due diligence reviews and internal investigations of global companies and financial institutions in order to mitigate threats to financial, business, and information security operations.

Campbell joined SRNL on August 12, 2019, as the Director of Mission Assurance. At that time, he worked with the Deputy Lab Director to prepare for the initiation of the new SRNL Mission Assurance Program, which was formally established on October 1, 2019.
