As Associate Laboratory Director, Operations and Facilities, Steve Howell has overall leadership responsibility for all SRNL nuclear and non-nuclear laboratory facility operations; environment, safety, health and quality assurance; facility engineering; procedures and training; infrastructure planning; nuclear and criticality safety; and safeguards and security.

EXPERIENCE

Mr. Howell has over 30 years of service at the Savannah River Site (SRS), including 15 years at F Canyon in Engineering and Operations Management. He also served as Deputy Facility Manager of the Liquid Waste Operations H Tank Farm for two years before becoming the H Canyon Facility Manager in 2006. In 2011, he became Deputy Director of EM Operations at SRS, which includes E Area Solid Waste Management, F&H Area nuclear materials processing, and nuclear materials storage in K and L Areas. In 2015, he became Director of the SRNS Business Planning & Integration organization.

RECENT NOTEWORTHY

Mr. Howell is a graduate of the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations (INPO) five-week Senior Nuclear Plant Manager course and has mentored INPO courses for managers and supervisors. He has presented multiple papers on safe operation of nuclear facilities, including the American Nuclear Society national conference in Washington, D.C., the SRS Citizens Advisory Board, and the Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board. He has also developed and presented training materials related to radiological chemical separations for the International Nonproliferation Export Control Program sponsored by the DOE National Nuclear Security Administration.
